Introduction Session

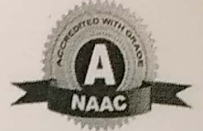

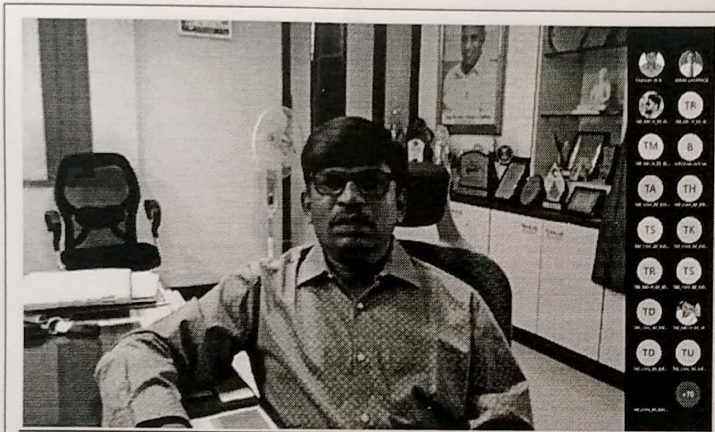
He practically shows how to give citation to paper content. Along with that he explain various tools required for paper writing. At end in question-answer session he clear doubt of all student.



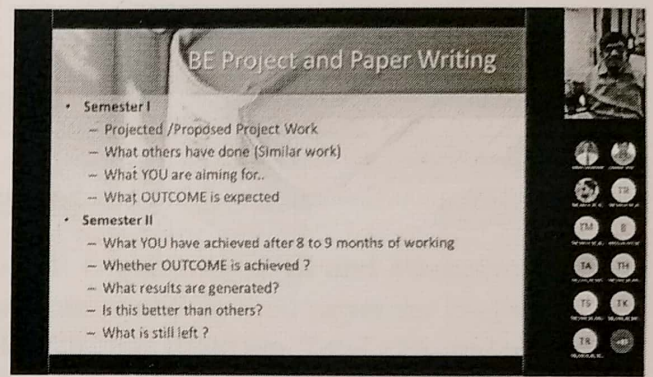
Program outcome

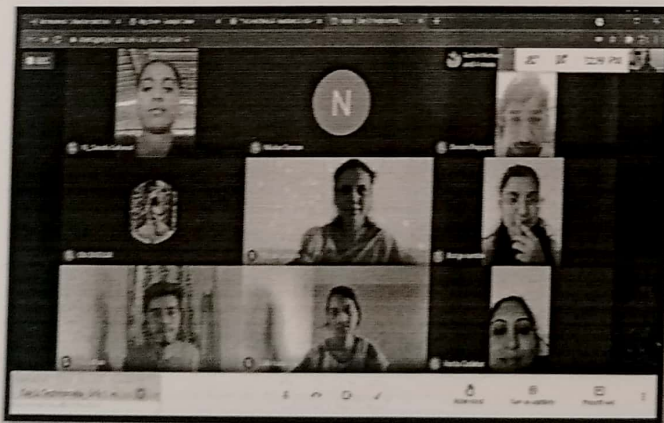
